## Invitation for Prequalification

The Democratic Republic of the Congo has applied for financing from the OPEC Fund for International Development (hereafter "OPEC Fund") toward the cost of the Kinshasa Cancer Center Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for the Construction and Equipment of the Kinshasa Cancer Center.
2. The "*Commissariat Général à l'Energie Atomique*" (hereafter "CGEA") intends to prequalify contractors for the construction of the Kinshasa Cancer Center on full turnkey (Engineering Procurement and Construction – EPC) basis. The selected EPC Contractor will deliver, on a full turnkey basis, the design and construction of modern Oncology Center with an annual capacity of 1,000 patients along with supply, installation and commissioning of medical equipment on full turnkey basis. The EPC Contractor shall assume complete responsibility for architectural, technical, medical, IT and mechanical system, in full in accordance with international hospital engineering standards, International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) safety guidelines, the financiers Environment and Social requirements and the technical specifications in the prequalification document (Section VII – Scope of Works). It is expected that the Request for Bids will be made by *April 2026*.
3. Prequalification will be conducted through the procedures as specified in the OPEC Fund's *Principles for Procurement of Goods, Works and Services* and *Procedures for Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-consulting Services* (collectively called "*Procurement Framework*"), and is open to all eligible Applicants as defined in the Procurement Framework.
4. Interested eligible Applicants may obtain further information from the Project and Public Procurement Management Unit of the CGEA at the address below during office hours [09:00 to 15:00 hours]. A complete set of prequalification documents in *English* may be purchased by interested Applicants on the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of 1 200 000 Francs Congolais or US\$ 525. The method of payment will be cash. The document will be sent by person or via a logistics and express transport company such as DHL, at the expense of the Interested eligible Applicants .
5. Applications for prequalification should be submitted in clearly marked envelopes and delivered to the address below by 12:00 on 23 March 2026. Late applications may be rejected.
